ATHLETES will be permitted to bring in back packs and a water bottle. The following restrictions are for ALL OTHER ATTENDEES.

IMPORTANT

- Clear bag no larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- Small clutch or purse no larger 4.5" x 8"
- Larger bags, outside food/beverage and water bottles will not be allowed to enter the building.

WARM UP ROOM ACCESS



NO ENTRY TO WARM UP WITHOUT THE FOLLOWING:

- AAU Membership with passed background check (coaches & adult athletes*),
- Government issued ID for all athletes and coaches,
- Athletes and Coaches must be on the roster for team in warm ups to enter.

*AAU/WASF definition of adult athletes are anyone who is 18 or older and no longer in high school. Any athlete in high school, regardless of age is considered a youth athlete and does not need a background check.

WARM UP

- 5 MINS, STRETCH/STUNT MAT
- 5 MINS, TUMBLE STRIPS
- 10 MINS, FULL SPRING FLOOR

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

Osceola Heritage Park and its venues are equipped with an Emergency Operations System. Staff members are trained in emergency preparedness and evacuation procedures. Key employees are assigned to assist patrons with disabilities to safety.

In the event of an emergency, please remain calm and walk to the nearest exit in an orderly fashion. Follow posted signs and listen to announcements for specific instructions. In some circumstances you will be directed to remain in the building and staff will direct you where to go. Please do not use the elevator. If you are disabled, trained staff members will assist you in getting to safety.



Eligibility Policy

All participants and gyms competing at the WASF
 Championship must be WASF members. Please follow our instructions to register your program and athletes with WASF and AAU for event compliance. LINK

Tie Breaker Policy

In the event of a tie, the following tie breaker policy will apply:

- The bid will be awarded to the team with the highest percent value score, before deductions.
- If the percent value score is equal, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest combined score from Stunts, Tumbling, and Pyramid.
- If the combined score above is equal, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest combined execution score from Stunts, Tumbling, and Pyramid.

Crossover Policy

• Athletes may crossover to up to 2 teams.

Advancement to Finals Policy

 Advancing to Finals - Top 5 teams will advance to the finals in each division. If less than 5 teams are in the division, all teams will automatically advance.

TEAM REGISTRATION

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR TEAMS

How to Register for the Event

- 1. Create a Reg Champ Account with the WASF.
 - a. If you have an account with another event producer you can easily merge the information from that account into your WASF account by using the same email address when you sign up.
- 2.Once you have entered Reg Champ select "Events" on the home page.
- 3. Select "Go" next to the event "2024 WASF Championship"
- 4. Time to add your teams!
 - a.If you have teams uploaded to your Reg Champ account, select teams you wish to register for The WASF Championship from the "Import Team" drop down menu and then click "Import Team."
 - i. Select the correct division for your team and hit "Save"ii. If you do not see yoru team's division select "Check Division Criterea" to view the criteria for your desired division.
 - iii.On the next screen confirm your division selection is correct and hit "Done".
 - b.If you do not have teams uploaded to your account yet, select the 3 stacked cubes on the left hand side of the screen labeled "Teams".
 - i.If you have rosters ready to be uploaded select "Create a New Team" and follow the prompts.
 - ii.If you do not have rosters ready select "Create Express Team without Roster" and follow the prompts. Note: Be sure to go back an upload your rosters ASAP as they will be required in order to book any lodging for on property events, and to place your team in their division.
- 5. You are now able to view your invoice and you will follow the prompts to make your \$100 per team deposit.

The World Allstar Federation (WASF) is leading the way in competitive cheer with a scoring system encompassing education, knowledge, transparency and accuracy.

- Your scoresheet is divided into 3 sections, and each section has 3 judges responsible for your final score of that section.
- After the building, tumbling and routine judges have come to an agreement on your final scores, the Deductions Judge will apply building deductions to your BUILDING SCORE and tumbling deductions to your TUMBLING SCORE.
- Then any rule violations will be deducted from your raw score, and this will then give you your final score.

DEDUCTIONS

TUMBLING DEDUCTIONS

Tumbling deductions will be deducted from the total tumbling score.

• Minor Tumbling Deduction: O.5 points

An unintentional landing that results with feet and an additional single body part (i.e., feet and hand, feet and forearm, feet and elbow, or foot and knee) touching the performance surface.

• Major Tumbling Deduction: O.9 points

An unintentional landing that results with multiple body parts touching the performance surface. (feet excluded)

BUILDING DEDUCTIONS

Building deductions will be deducted from the total building score.

Minor Building Deduction: O.7 points

An unintentional building fall demonstrating some control for immediate or prompt recovery and/or completion.

Major Building Deduction: 1.2 points

An unintentional and out of control building fall.
